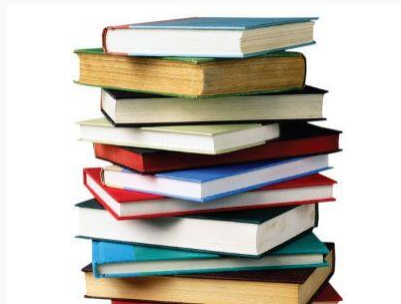




### Happy Friday the 13th!

### **What: Craft Together**

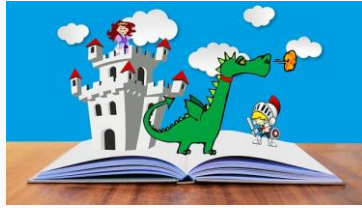
When: 2nd Saturday (February 11, March 11, April 8.....)
