
## **Autumn Means New Beginnings**

Calendars for September are now available online and in the library.



#### What a Season!

Phew! July is always the busiest month here at the library, but normally we see things wind down through August. Much to our delight, though, we've continued to see strong numbers with plenty of visitors all month long!

Last month, I thanked our patrons for making our summer great... this month, I wanted to share some numbers to really emphasize how incredible this July has been.

Starting with **circulation**: just between the start of July and our finale on August 1st, our patrons checked out <u>2,366</u> books (plus another <u>98</u> audiobooks!) You also checked out a total of <u>166</u> DVDs and Blu-rays and <u>15</u> board games and adventure backpacks!

Program-wise, we had <u>58</u> **programs** in five weeks, <u>34</u> for kids and families, <u>24</u> for adults (a new record!) In those programs, we saw a whopping <u>874</u> **participants for our children's programs** and a stunning <u>246</u> **for adult ones!** 

As thanks for turning up, we held a total of 30 free raffles.

Finally, the **Dragon Trading Cards**. As excited as I was to try them out, I wasn't sure if kids would like them. Well, I needn't have worried; we had <u>90</u> kids participating, with more than <u>25</u> collecting them all! With such an enthusiastic response, rest assured that the Reading Dragons will return in 2026 with all new cards to collect.

I knew this summer *felt* special, but looking at the numbers really cemented it for me. It was busy, but it was worth it all. With that said, it's nice to be returning to normal, at least for a little while. We'll kick back into gear in October and December, but for this month?

We've *still* got a lot going on, actually. I daresay, life's more fun this way. Even outside of our bombastic specials, we hope you'll come on by and join us!
